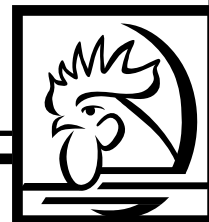

Dying moments gives us an opportunity to acknowledge our struggles in a safe and spiritual environment, to give them over to God, and then make our own His love and mercy and forgiveness in our lives. Often times this process must be repeated daily; giving to God those things we struggle with, accepting His grace, mercy, and forgiveness. We then move forward as a redeemed person in that area of struggle, even if only for a day, knowing that God will be with us and work with us in the struggle every second of the day for the redemption of our lives.

I pray that this New Year "dying moments" will continue to be a part of all of our ongoing prayer, devotional, study, fellowship, relational, and worship life with God. May we all know that an honest and straightforward relationship with Jesus is the only way our dying moments may truly die for good. And then may we go out and serve others - bringing them good news of Jesus Christ - out of our gratitude for His love and grace in our lives!

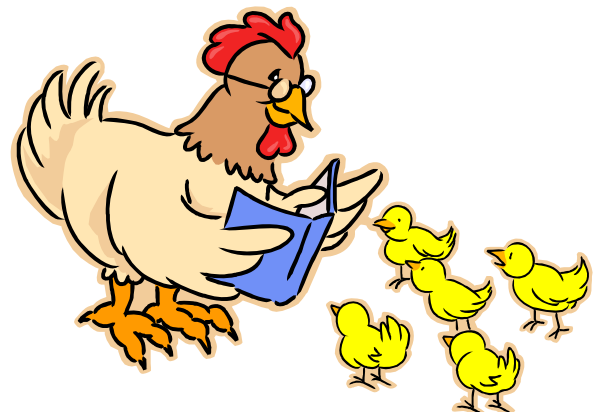
This theme has echoed through all teams that were called for this year. I want to thank the Lay Directors for their patience and diligence in calling all who were chosen.

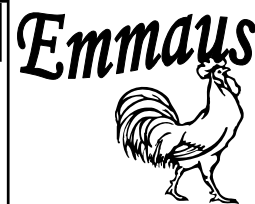

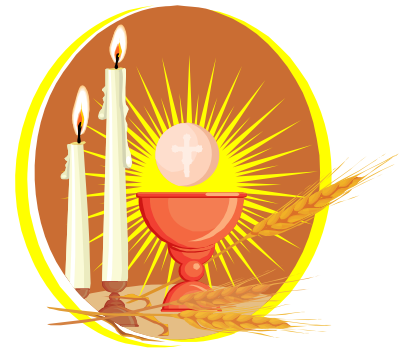

How selfish! How self centered!

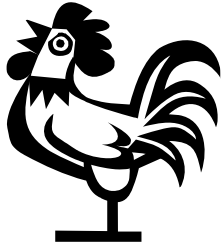
