HAVE YOU SEEN JESUS?

As several of us behind-the-scenes-workers prepared for candlelight on an Emmaus Walk, we actually had this conversation:

"Have you seen Jesus? I can't find Him."

"Isn't He in the supply closet? And if not there, did someone leave him in the chapel?"

"No, I looked everywhere, I just can't find Jesus!"

We did find our Jesus statue in time for candlelight but not before an Emmaus song scampered through my mind:

Have you seen Jesus my Lord

He's here in plain view

Take a look, open your eyes,

He'll show life to you.

I saw **the-real-Jesus** everywhere on my Emmaus walks. In people's loving faces, words, and acts. In the songs and worship. In Dying moments and Candlelight. And of course, the Agape. If the youth of today are to prosper, then we need to follow God's words and **Pray**. If the youth of today are to hear and feel God's love, then we need to **Pray** for those who have gone on a Chrysalis Flight and those who are led to go in the future. **Pray** for the youth that have said, "yes" to serving on the Chrysalis board. **Pray** for the youth on all Chrysalis teams. **Pray** for the youth of Big House. **Pray** for Caterpillars signed up for Chrysalis Flights. **Pray** for the youth that come to our thoughts for sponsoring. **Pray** for Chrysalis committees as they are being formed. **Pray** about getting involved with a committee in a whole new way of serving. GET EXCITED!

In Corinthians 12:4-6: the bible says: "There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but the same God works all of them in all men." (NIV)

God needs your spiritual gift shared with others to reach youth in communities through Chrysalis Flights. All of us have a gift - Remember your retreat? Some of us have an abundance of time, others only a split second. All of us can find a way of supporting the youth today...in services that are different!

Getting involved is the second step. **Pray** that God helps you to open your mouth and say, "yes" to His call and get involved. Serving on a Chrysalis team is an extreme high, but, Chrysalis Flights start long before the team names are presented to us from God. The Chrysalis committees prayers, planning and action are the second step of all Chrysalis Flights. **Pray** about being a part of this second step. Know that more community members and less flights make our team service less frequent than previously.

Third step is the actual Flight Team Selection. **Pray** that God introduces servants He wants on team. The selection of God's servants takes involvement of a committee with members from all over the North Indiana Chrysalis area. Chrysalis team selection needs youth and adults to help with discerning names that God has introduced to them to serve on team.

Fourth step Sponsorship. **Pray** for the youth-that sponsors will discern the youth to ask through prayers. **Pray** that the youth say, "yes" to the sponsor only after the youth prays about what God has offered them. North Indiana Chrysalis has 8,000 to 10,000 possible sponsors in God's community. All of should **Pray** that God touches us with a name of one youth who He want to get closer to and show His love.

Final step... **Pray!**

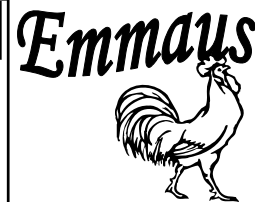

The Power of Prayer

This prayer was given in Kansas at the opening session of their Senate. It seems prayer still upsets some people. When Minister Joe Wright was asked to open the new session of the Kansas Senate, everyone was expecting the usual generalities, but this is what they heard:

"Heavenly Father, we come before you today to ask your forgiveness and to seek your direction and guidance.

We know Your Word says, 'Woe to those who call evil good,' but that is exactly what we have done.

We have lost our spiritual equilibrium and reversed our values.

We have exploited the poor and called it the lottery. We have rewarded laziness and called it welfare.

We have killed our unborn and called it choice.

We have shot abortionists and called it justifiable.

We have neglected to discipline our children and called it building self esteem.

We have abused power and called it politics.

We have coveted our neighbor's possessions and called it

ambition. We have polluted the air with profanity and pornography and called it freedom

of expression.

We have ridiculed the time-honored values of our forefathers and called it enlightenment. Search us, Oh, God, and know our hearts today; cleanse us from every sin and set us free. Amen!"

The response was immediate. A number of legislators walked out during the prayer in protest.

In 6 short weeks, Central Christian Church, where Rev. Wright is pastor, logged more than 5,000 phone calls with only 47 of those calls responding negatively. The church is now receiving international requests for copies of this prayer from India, Africa and Korea.

Commentator Paul Harvey aired this prayer on his radio program, "The Rest of the Story," and received a larger response to this program than any other he has ever aired.

With the Lord's help, may this prayer sweep over our nation and wholeheartedly become our desire so that we again can be called "one nation under God."

"If you don't stand for something, you will fall for everything."
